












































### A first impression

This enchanting property, enveloped by centuries-old olive groves and accessed through a majestic gate that anticipates the beauty of the property, is characterized by a charming historic wall that is also a guarantee of privacy and security. Spread over three levels, all entirely above ground, the building requires major renovation, while the roof has recently been renovated. The splendid lake view can be enjoyed from the first and second floors, offering a unique panorama that enriches the living experience. The approved extension project includes the enhancement of the attic and increased volume on the ground floor, where a generously sized swimming pool can be built. A renovation investment of about € 700,000 is estimated to transform this dwelling into a true exclusive retreat. Come and see it to discover the charm of this unique mansion.

### All about the location

History notes A center of Etruscan origin, according to tradition, in Roman times it was called BENACUM and rose to become the capital of the Brescian Riviera of Lake Garda. It experienced a period of splendor between the 10th and 13th centuries, thanks to a series of privileges granted first by Otto I, then by Frederick Barbarossa and Robert of Anjou, king of Sicily. Especially thanks to Barbarossa it obtained partial autonomy, while in 1377 it lost its role as capital of the Riviera, according to the will of Beatrice della Scala, who moved the capital of the "Magnifica Patria" to Salò. Under Venetian rule it fell under the territorial ambit of the Quadra di Maderno. Particularly rich is the artistic heritage: in addition to the remains of splendid floors belonging to a villa built in the Etruscan age and the monument to the Brescian statesman Giuseppe Zanardelli, one can admire the 17thcentury Palazzo Mafizzoli, the sumptuous palace of the "Serraglio," and several buildings of sacred architecture. These include the sanctuary of the Madonna del Benaco, which existed as early as the 5th century, the church of Ss. Peter and Paul, built at the end of the 16th century and commissioned by S. Carlo Borromeo, the parish church of Sant'Ercolano, and the church of S. Bartolomeo. Location and climate Toscolano Maderno lies on a wide promontory enclosed between the romantic port of Toscolano and the picturesque Gulf of Maderno. The municipality of Toscolano-Maderno is located on the Brescian shore of Lake Garda, which is 40 km from the provincial capital Brescia. The climate is mild throughout the year and very comfortable. On wonderful spring days one can witness the triumph of nature in bloom, in summer the light breeze mitigates the high temperatures, autumn offers enchanting sunny days, and even in winter the temperatures remain pleasant. Natural beauties in the surroundings Garda Island, the largest island on the entire Lake Garda, belongs to the municipality of San Felice del Benaco. On the island is the luxurious palace of the Cavazza family, surrounded by beautiful Italian gardens and a rich forest composed of cypresses, acacias, and pines. Guided tours of this breathtaking island are organized with the Cavazza family between April and October. Feel the heavenly atmosphere of this small island on your skin. The Heller Botanical Garden and the Vittoriale degli Italiani are popular destinations for visitors from all over the world. The mountains above, by the way easily accessible on foot, offer breathtaking scenery. Garda's culinary arts Varied are the excellent restaurants in the area but the most renowned are :Lido 84 (starred restaurant), Gatto d'oro, la tana, il Cortiletto and excellent pizzerias. Lake Garda sports. Lake Garda is known for water sports, first and foremost sailing with the important regattas held every year in the Benaco waters, but also wakeboarding (water skiing), kitesurfing, windsurfing, canoeing, snorkeling, not forgetting the hottest water sport of the moment: stand up paddling (SUP). Thrill-seekers can experience the thrill of hang gliding and paragliding from the top of



Mount Spino and Mount Baldo. A variety of golf courses can be reached within 15 km, Arzaga, Garda, and Colombaro. Walks on foot, bicycle or horseback will make your experiences magical, there are more than 100 km of bicycle paths going from the lakeside to hillside trails. For snow lovers, the prestigious resort of Madonna di Campiglio can be reached in just under two hours by car. Public and private ports - Port of Salò ( public and private) - Port of Maderno (public) - Port of Torchio - Manerba del Garda ( private) - Port of Gardone Riviera (public and private) Beaches Salò and surroundings It boasts some beautiful beaches: the Degli Ulivi beach, Lido Azzurro and Riva Granda. If you have a four-legged friend, the Riva Grande beach is for you: very generously sized, it has a rescue service, kiosk, watering holes and play area for dogs and children. Rive Grandi beach in Barbarano. Rimbalzello Beach.
